Topic	Mastering intermediate level conversation and listening skills.
Class Outline	Students will talk about "Culture Notes" to understand Japanese
	culture. Shadowing conversation is done for students to get used to
	speaking Japanese naturally and by looking over the contents will help
	students to understand the flow of Japanese conversation.
	Students will also learn the "Key points of Conversation Exercise" from
	each chapter and master the skills used in the dialogues. Role plays and
	group based conversation practices will be done using skills learned
	from "Key points of Conversation Exercise" which help students using
	these skills within everyday conversation. Composition writing will be
	required to be handed in as homework every week based on the
	discussed topic in class. Students will also be required to listen to the
	textbook CD after each class for homework and answers to the listening
	exercises will be discussed in the following week.
Objectives	1. The topic "Exchange student living in Japan" is used for this class to
	aim student's understanding of Japan and develop speaking and
	listening skills.
	2. The aim for speaking is to master skills to speak naturally depending
	on the interlocutor and situation.
	3. The aim for listening is to listen and understand the important
