Haven't we gone too far? It is time for us to call a (a) <u>ban</u> on all experimentation with human \*genes if we want to protect the human race. If scientists continue to \*tinker with genes in their laboratories, they might create human monsters! Perhaps their experiments will one day lead to cures for the hereditary diseases passed on through the generations. They may also help improve food production and insect control. However, no one knows today what negative results these experiments might bring to our lives in the future. By then it might be too late, and the effects these experiments will have had on people could be \*irreversible.

A resolution must be passed by the government to watch over and (b) all future experiments. Otherwise, the situation could (c) get out of control. Scientists have already \*manipulated genes, in their laboratories, which haven't yet been released into the environment. This is because they are not sure what will happen once the genes are released. They don't know what long-term effects these changed genes could have on our world.

Yet some people continue to believe there is only a remote possibility that genetic engineering could have a negative effect on the environment. They tend to see only the good that this experimentation might bring to the world. However, many of us see this experimentation as dangerous. Our fears are not \*unfounded. We need only to look at history. Man has consistently been surprised by the results of his experimentation.

So, until we can \*refine, to perfection, the techniques (d) <u>used</u> in genetic engineering, we should not be playing around with genes. The government should begin to \*curtail all genetic engineering until scientists are a hundred percent sure of what the long-term results of their experiments will be on us, the human race.
